Welcome to RMC's May 2024 Newsletter.


This Newsletter is designed to inform you of new developments within the practice, any health issues/campaigns that may be happening or any other news that is relevant.

General Practice is working harder than ever with 90% of patients being seen but only given 8% of the NHS budget. Over the years, hospitals and other secondary providers have passed work on to General Practice that is no longer sustainable and is actually within the contract for them to complete. This includes things like issuing Fit

(Sick) Notes, giving out results, organising follow up appointments or prescribing medications. This increased workload is putting pressure on an already very busy staff so therefore, from the 1st May, General Practice will no longer be undertaking this unfunded activity and it will be passed back to secondary providers to complete. We are committed to ensuring that General Practice remains sustainable so that we can continue looking after our patients.



We hope you are enjoying the **sunny** weather but remember it's very important to protect yourself. Always wear **SPF** to protect yourself against sunburn and to reduce your risk of developing skin cancer. Also make sure you keep hydrated, take extra care with children, protect your eyes and keep in the shade especially between 11am and 3pm wherever possible.
